We are sure you have noticed that there is a great big double decker bus parked in the school's nature garden. This is still a work in progress but it is going to be amazing when it is done.

Last year the Friends applied for a grant from the Aviva Community Fund. After receiving thousands of votes (thank you everyone!) we were awarded £10,000 to purchase and convert a double decker bus into a new library and unique learning space.

There have been many challenges along the way – like filling in a 13m long pond, laying concrete, widening the track so that the bus would fit into its new home, and getting it towed into position to name but a few.
