### Monday 11th November



Last week we were learning ...

Maths: We started our work on measurement. This week we have been looking at the value of single coins and groups of coins. We have been trying to find different combinations to make the same amount.

Líteracy: We have been writing our own versions of Lost and Found, using mind maps to lay out our ídeas.

Science: We took lots of different materials and looked at what happened to the shape when we manipulated them.

Geography: we focussed on the four countries that make up the UK and their capital cities.

We are also using globes to find key features like the poles and the equator.



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# Next week we will be learning...

Maths: we will continue with the value of coins and look at measurement of length and weight.

Líteracy: We will be making fact files on arctic animals; thinking about non-fiction writing.

Science: we will be starting a new unit looking at how important it is for humans to exercise, eat healthily and practise good hygiene.

Geography: we will be comparing the poles and the equator: the weather and the animals/habitats.
